To import records from ABC-CLIO databases (*America: History & Life and Historical Abstracts*) into Endnote, a search must be completed. After the desired results have been obtained follow these steps:

1. Mark the desired records by clicking the beside its citation, then click in on the “Export Options” link.

 ASCII Display Tab-Delimited Display
Use the export button to display selected entries without graphics or special characters. Then use the browser "Print" function to send the display to a printer, or the "Save As" function to Save the text to a file.

RefWorks
Use the export button to export selected entries to your RefWorks account.

EndNote ProCite Reference Manager
Use the export button to export selected entries to EndNote, ProCite or Reference Manager in RIS format. One of these programs must be installed on your computer for export to work.

E-mail in Plain Text E-mail in RIS Format
Use the export/send button to e-mail the selected entries. Multiple e-mail addresses in the To: field should each be separated by a space.
