



JSTOR Records and Endnote

To import records from JSTOR into Endnote, a search must first be completed. After the desired results have been obtained follow these steps:

1. Mark the desired record(s) for export to Endnote by clicking the “Save Citation” link for each record you wish to import, and then click the link for “View Saved Citations.”
