It is not too late to request a library workshop for your students. Please contact me for any questions about our library services.

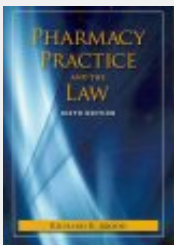

Are you getting the most out of "My Account"?



All faculty members have access to the library through "My Account". "My Account" allows you to:

- 1) view and renew checked out materials
- 2) save "preferred searches" in the catalog and receive alerts when new materials are added that match your search
- 3) keep a record of the materials you have borrowed (optional).
