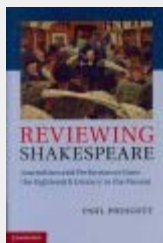

iPOLL is the largest source for opinion polling data. Data covers 1935 to the present on a broad range of topics. Questions can be searched by keyword, topic, date, or source. The database includes polls from many sources: major news organizations (CBS, ABC, Associated Press, etc.), public opinion research centers (Gallup, Harris, Pew,

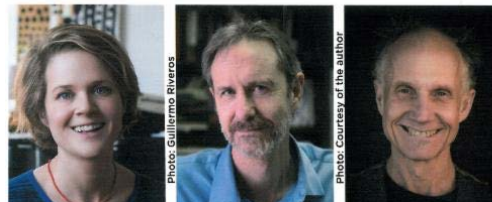
