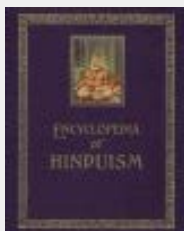

Hansard's online database of parliamentary proceedings from the United Kingdom, 1803-2005

I only recently learned about Hansard's. A fine example of no-frills, open access to important information, Hansards can help trace the ebb and flow of ideas for the British Empire and the United Kingdom. Searching for John Stuart Mill, for example, reveals the degree to which his name is invoked in parliamentary discussions (a lot!). 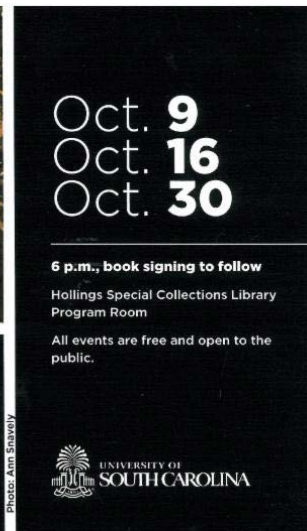
