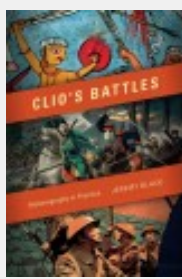

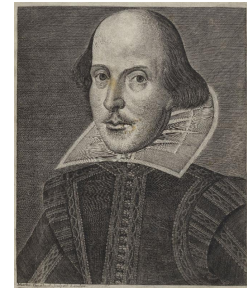

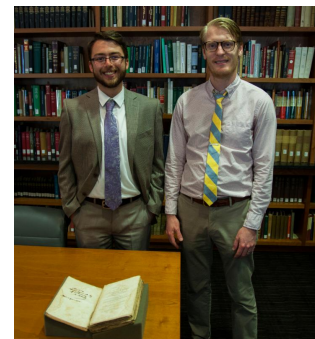


Undergraduate Research Award

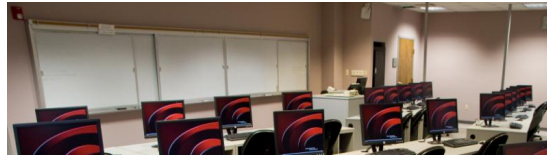
Did your students submit great work last fall that made use of library resources or services? Are you expecting solid projects this term?
