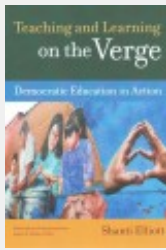

Use 'eRequest' for book requests. Remember to continue submitting requests for books you would like the library to add to the collection.

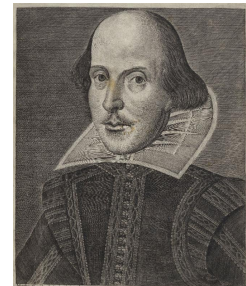

Undergraduate Research Award

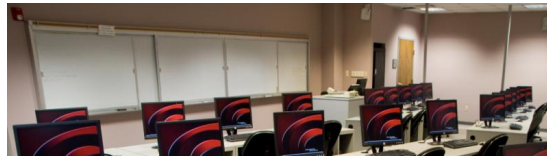
Did your students submit great work last fall that made use of library resources or services? Are you expecting solid projects this term?
