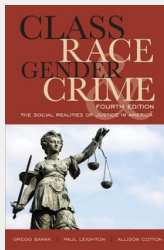

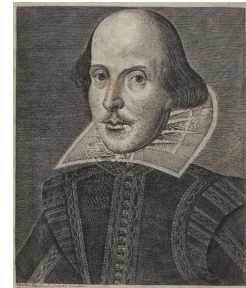

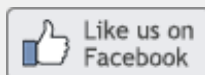
Shakespeare is coming with "First Folio!"

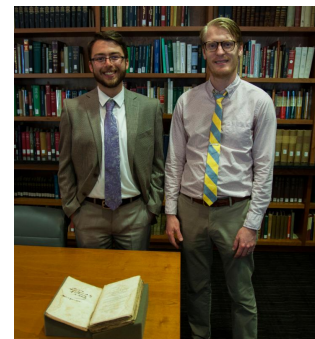


Undergraduate Research Award
