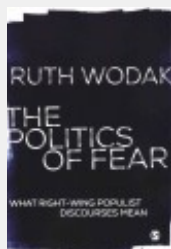

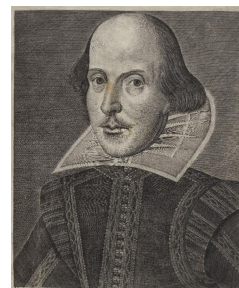

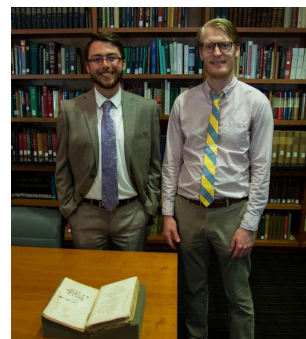


Undergraduate Research Award

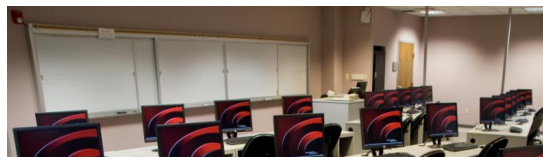
