Hello from Thomas Cooper Library!

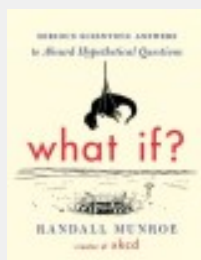
I hope you all had a great summer. To our new faculty members, welcome!
