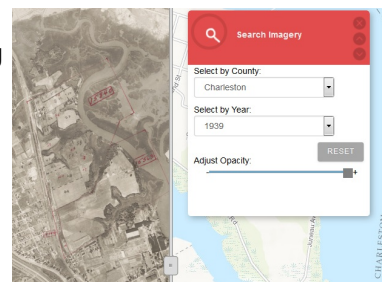

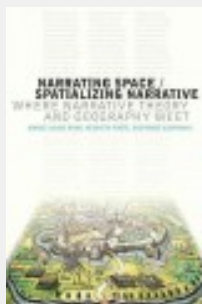
## South Carolina Aerial Photography
