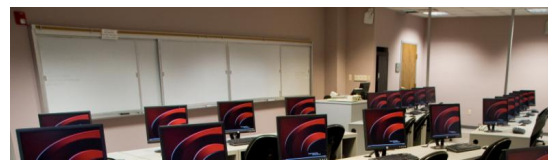
Institutional Repository
