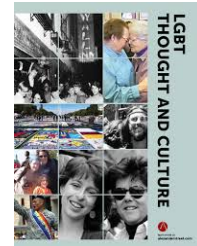

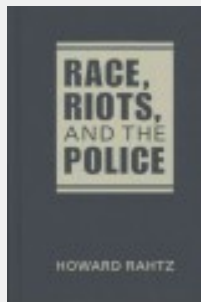

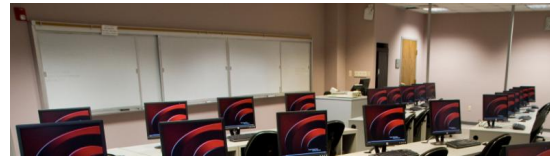
## Institutional Repository
