#### **[Educational Film Collection](#)**

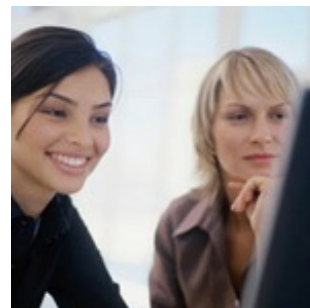

#### **[Online Digital Collections](#)**

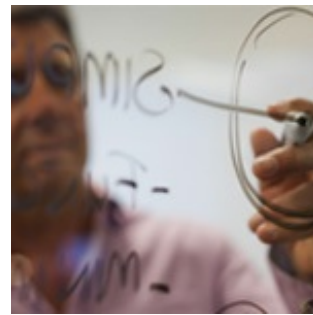

## FOR YOUR RESEARCH

### [Access USC Full-text from Google Scholar](#)

You can set up Google Scholar to include links to University Libraries subscription content for full-text article access. In Google Scholar's Settings, click on Library Links and add **University of South Carolina Columbia - USC Columbia eText** and also **University of South Carolina School of Medicine - find Fulltext@ USC Med** to easily access the library's subscription content.



### [Institutional Repository](#)

Scholar Commons is the institutional repository for USC. You are encouraged to submit open access material in all formats. Search open access publications from 400 other affiliated Institutional Repositories from around the world.

### [Locate Online Journals by Title](#)

Search by publication title to determine if USC has electronic access to articles from journals, magazines and newspapers. If you do not find your journal title listed, use the library's catalog to determine if the journal is available in print.

### [Request books for the library collection](#)

Submit a request for a title that you would like to see added to the library collection using eRequest online request form.

Register for ILL! You can borrow books and journal articles from other libraries, and you can get articles from the University Libraries' collections sent directly to your desktop.

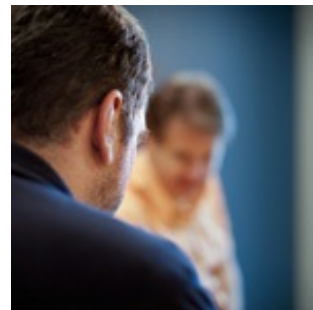
### [PASCAL Delivers](#)
