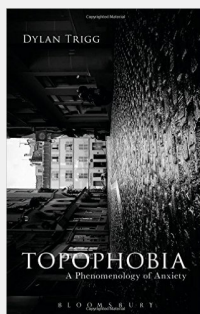

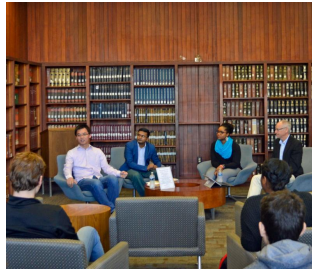

Scholars Corner - We want to partner with you!

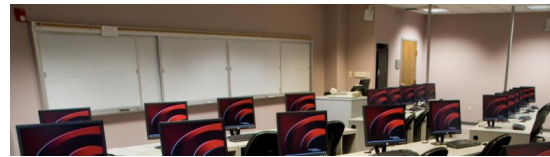
