Census Data for Small and Large Areas and Census Tracts

American Factfinder <http://factfinder.census.gov>

Step 1: find out what census geographic area(s) best matches your community (usually a census tract(s)) and find a tract number for your area.

- a. **Address Search** - find the census tract number for an area if a street address is known.
- b. **Reference Maps** - customized maps to locate a census tract number if street address is unknown.

Step 2: find census data for a known census tract(s) or area(s).

Data Sets

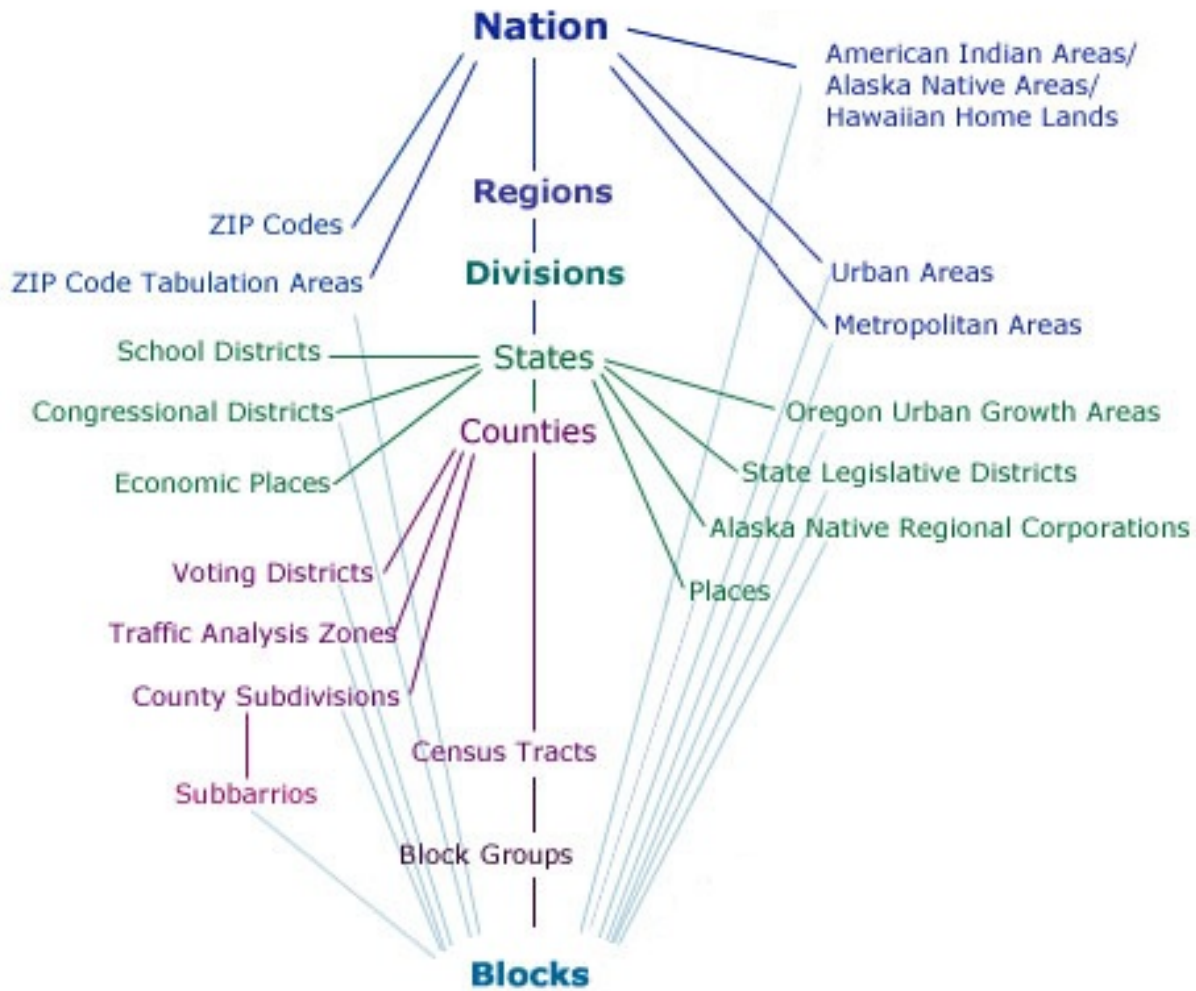
- a. **2000 Summary File 1**
100% data from the census short form to the *block* level on age, race, sex, Hispanic or Latino origin, household relationship, owners and renters and more...
- b. **2000 Summary File 2** - same data as File 1 but for detailed race and ethnic groups.
- c. **2000 Summary File 3**
Sample data from the census long form to the *block group* level on ancestry, disability, educational attainment, income, language spoken at home, marital status, occupation, poverty, school enrollment and more...
- d. **2000 Summary File 4** - same data as File 3 but for detailed race and ethnic groups.

Community Fact Sheet – see Fast Access to Information; Summary profiles by city/town, county, zip

American Community Survey (ACS) – annual survey designed to identify demographic changes since the last decennial census.
