[Drafts and final versions](#) of newsletters produced by Hollings' office and mailed to constituents from 1967 to 1981 and 1985 to 1989; and [letters from constituents in reaction](#) to the newsletters, 1967 to 1976.

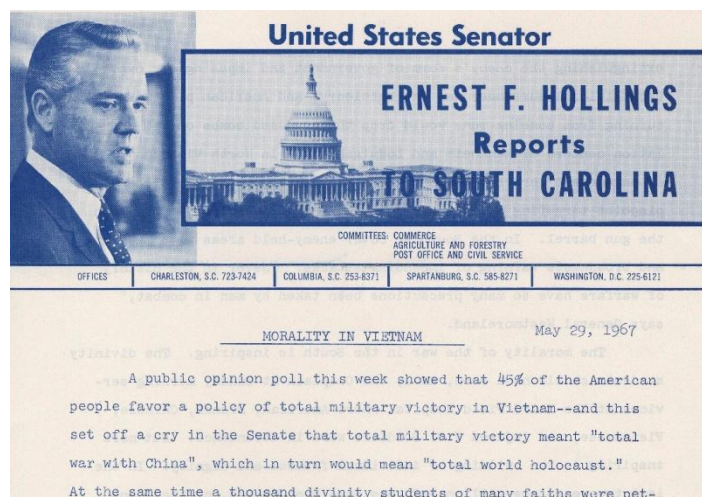
[Press Office files](#), 1969 to 2003, with Hollings' responses to newspaper coverage and letters between the Senator and members of the media.

[Press releases](#), 1966 to 2004, though releases from 1997 to 1999 are noticeably incomplete.

Transcripts of the ["Straight Talk from Washington"](#) radio interviews, 1971 to 1985, during which Hollings explained how he viewed events unfolding in Washington from the points of view of politician and citizen and what he felt would be the best corrective course of action.
